# 2011 On-Ice Fantasy Hockey Draft

## Prizes, Rules & Guidelines

### Eligibility

- By completion of an entry form with \$400 entry fee payment. Due to space limitations, participation will be accepted on a first come basis.
- Each team will have a drafting committee consisting of up to four members.

#### • General Manager

**Duties:** Make official team selections and announce them to the draft congregation from the podium.

**Main qualifications:** Loud voice and good pronunciation, knowledge of Russian and other European languages an asset.

#### • Coach

**Duties:** The GM's right hand man and advisor. Use the power of persuasion to get the player you want.

**Main qualifications:** Pompous assertiveness, ability to read, access to hockey news or other authoritative material.

#### • Water Boy

**Duties:** Keep the team hydrated and in good spirits.

**Main Qualifications:** Deep pockets, tough skin and quick feet. Must show agility and poise when carrying copious amounts of liquid inventory across a large room.

#### • Heckler

**Duties:** To distract and demean the competition.

**Main qualifications:** Must be witty and obnoxious with a large repertoire of put-downs. An outrageous Don Cherry jacket would be fitting attire.

### The Draft

- Each drafting committee will draft a team consisting of players from any NHL team roster.
- The draft will consist of 11 rounds with each team drafting one player on each round.
- Each team will consist of 10 players and one goalie.

Your top 9 players and goalie will count towards your point total. This will compensate for an injury occurring on your team.

- The drafting order will be determined via lottery just prior to the start of the draft.
- The first draft round will be in order and the second draft round will be in reverse order. For example, the drafting committee with the #14 pick will also have the #15 pick and then the #28 pick.
- Each pick must be made within 3 minutes of the previous pick for the first two rounds and within one minute for every round thereafter (rounds 3-11).
- Waiver exchange; each team is allowed one waiver exchange (add/drop) for a cost of \$50. It must be made on or before the NHL trade deadline. The exchange can take place at any time on a first come, first serve basis.

### Points System

- Each team will get one point for each goal and each assist credited to their teams players.
- Goalies will be awarded one point for a win and an additional 4 points for a shutout. As well as the standard scoring system for goals and assists.
- Interim and final results will be available on-line.

### Prizes

- First prize: \$800 and (4) Beer Fridges from Molson
- Second Prize: (4) Golf Passes to Paradise Canyon Golf Resort and (4) Molson Golf Shirts
- Third Prize: Molson Prize Pack
- In the event of a tie, prize money for the positions will be totaled and divided equally among the number of teams tied for that position.

### Notes

- Casual dress is appropriate and encouraged.
- Team names will be determined by your drafting committee – they may be as descriptive or humorous as you wish (within the bounds of good taste).
